<p>Shoes: Closed toed shoes are required</p> <p>Bedding: Sleeping bag or blankets for each member of your party.</p> <p><i>** All Cabins have BunkBeds with mattresses but do not offer pillows or blankets.</i></p>	<p>Sleep Items: Pillow</p> <p>Daytime clothing: dressing in layers / two full changes of clothes for each day is advised</p> <p>Warm evening clothing: Jackets, long pants, warm socks, beanie</p> <p>Sun Deterrent: Hat, Sunscreen</p> <p>Toiletries: toothbrush, soap, two personal towels</p> <p>Bug Deterrent: Bug repellent</p> <p>Snacks: Whatever snacks you may want to eat in between meals</p> <p>Hydration: personal water or Electrolytes</p>	<p>Medication: if you have medication that needs to be refrigerated, please let us know during your registration process.</p> <p>Small Children: If you have small / young Children, you must bring everything you will need to care for them including (but not limited to): diapers, bottles, food items, snacks, strollers and any items needed to care for your children.</p> <p>Camping Chair: if you have mobility issues, or if standing for prolonged periods is challenging, we optionally recommend having a camping chair for your comfort.</p>

Directions from Los Angeles Basin

1. Take interstate 10 East.
2. Exit Orange Street in downtown Redlands. Go straight and turn left (North) onto Orange Street.
3. Turn right (East) onto Lungonia Avenue: This becomes State Highway 38.
4. Follow State Highway 38 signs up the mountain for 28 miles, through the town of Angelus Oaks.
5. Camp Morning Star is just past the San Gorgonio public campground sign.
6. Look for a white mile-marker #28 and then make your first right into Camp Morning Star.
7. Where to Park: Follow the road and you will be greeted by the MLW Transportation Team who will instruct you where to park.
